Anoush Margaryan is Professor in the Department of Digitalization and holds the Endowed Chair of Blended Learning as part of CBS's cross-institutional, strategic project 'Research in Blended Learning' (2019-2024).

Anoush is a learning scientist specialising in workplace and organisational learning. She studies how people learn in the platform economy workplaces and how teaching and learning in educational institutions can be better aligned with the requirements of the world of work. Anoush works at the intersection of workplace learning, sociology and psychology drawing on mixed-method research and the Life Course perspective.

Anoush has led 17 collaborative, interdisciplinary, intersectoral, international research projects, funded by the UK Economic and Social Research Council, Shell, BP, ConocoPhillips, Centrica, Energy Institute, the UK Higher Education Academy, and the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training. She has received international awards for research excellence such as Alexander von Humboldt Senior Fellowship (2016-2018); Excellence in Research-to-Practice Award from the American Society of Training and Development (2005), and Shell Research Fellowship (2008-2010).
