# About the Survey

Administered to all CBS students

Survey period from 16 June to 16 July

45 questions<sup>1</sup>

1805 unique responses

Response rate varies by **education type** - on average 7.0%

Today mainly quantitative analysis

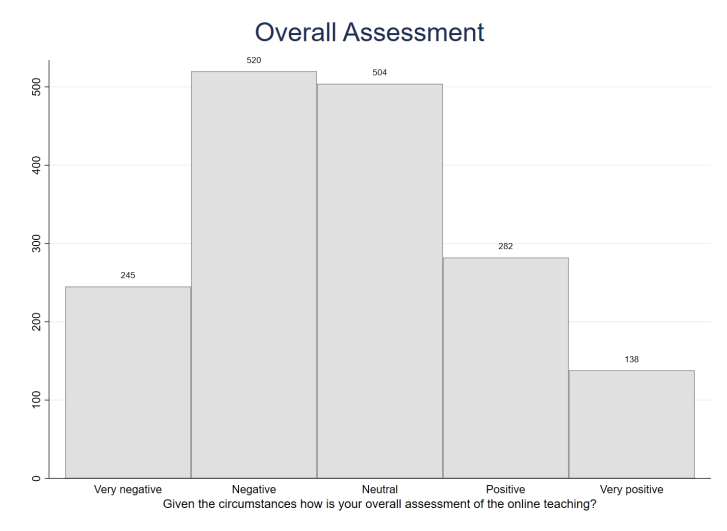

# Overall Questions

## Learning Outcome

Students also reported a tendency of working slightly less and having notably lower motivation

Still some heterogeneity but the conclusion of lower average self reported learning outcome applies to all education types

# Who answered the survey?

## Educational level, cohort, and grades

- Over-representation of BSc and Master(2 year) students

- More responses from relatively newer cohorts of students

- The respondents' have grades that are slightly higher (both during F20 and historically) than the average CBS student

## Gender, age, and nationality

- Slightly more female respondents and students aged 21-25 compared to full CBS student population

- Small differences in the respondents' nationality
